Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.		<p>RK University (RKU) has taken various measures to ensure that the syllabus of different courses are completed in time and in an appropriate manner. The syllabus is shared with all the students before the beginning of the semester and it is uploaded in the university website and course websites created on RKU's Learning Management System(LMS). RK University is one of the first universities in India to implement a self-hosted CANVAS learning management system (LMS) on university campus. Course website for all the courses being taught at RKU are hosted in the CANVAS LMS. These course websites include syllabus, reading material, assignments etc and also provides a platform for thought-provoking discussions. Before migrating to CANVAS LMS, RKU faculty members have used different LMS like Edmodo, Lore, Moodle, Google site etc. The link the RKU'S CANVAS LMS is :https://canvas.rku.ac.in/login/canvas</p> <p>Centre for Professional Development (CPD) is established at RKU to train the new faculty members for various pedagogical and assessment techniques, mentoring, research etc. Capacity Building Center (CBC) has been established under the ERASMUS+ capacity building in higher education project "CABCIN". CBC has taken initiative to take care of providing training to all the teaching about how to use the LMS, how to conduct online sessions using various tools like Microsoft team, Zoom, Google Meet etc. All the students are also trained for use of the CANVAS LMS in the beginning of their journey with RKU. Manuals and Video tutorials have been designed to help newcomers to learn the LMS. Using the LMS the students can easily track how much syllabus has been covered so far. During the Corona Pandemic, this center has provided all the necessary support to ensure that online learning can go on smoothly. All delivered sessions of faculty members are recorded and shared with the students to ensure that they use them for revision and also if some student has by chance missed the lecture, s/he will not suffer because of that. The concerned higher authorities have access to the different course websites and they regularly check the progress. They also take feedback from the students and teachers regularly.</p> <p>The Central examination department of RK University has also provided well-defined guidelines for theory and practical examinations to prepare online assessment on Canvas LMS for each program, and explained these guidelines to each teacher. The department has successfully conducted all semester end examinations in time and declared the university examinations' results in time. In order to extend students' and teachers' learning, RK University has organized 100+ webinars on different topics. The faculty members have also identified online MOOCs on different platforms SWAYAM COURSERA Edx and motivates the students to enroll for the same. All these measures are helping to ensure that the syllabus of each course and program gets completed in time in an efficient manner.</p>
