


Physio World - "Core Stability"

psoas.

Structural Stability is an essential component

of overall Functional Mobility. The principle to gain optimal functional mobility is the foremost aim of the therapeutic management. The most of soft tissue injuries and structural derangements are secondary to weak core structural stability during static



and dynamic activities.
Structural instability compromises functional mo-


bility (static and dynamic). Core stability plays vital role in overall physical performance. Structural stability consists of structural arrangement at artherokinematics and osteokinematics with kinetic control of inner and



out core muscles. The kinetic control further divides the core stability muscles into local (the inner core) and global (the outer core). **The inner**

core muscles are mostly single-joint, shorter muscles.They are designed

to control translation and the small glides that joints make. For the trunk and low back, these would include the transverse abdominals, deep multifidi, pelvic floor and posterior fibers of



outer core – the global stabilizer muscles. For the trunk and low back, these include the abdominal obliques, anterior psoas, gluteal muscles, quad-

ratus lumborum and the superficial multifidi. These are still tonic, onejoint muscles. These are considerably stronger than the inner core and work

in

tandem with it. They control specific directions of movement such as flexion, extension and rotation. Every joint complex has its own kinetic control system which plays vital role in overall structural arrangement and physical performance.
